

Pre-K-12 Federal Funding Resources

A summary of federal funding resources school districts can use to pay for professional development and programs for struggling learners.

Federal funding is available to help with a variety of areas, including:

Academic-Focused Solutions

- » After-School Programs
- » Extended Day Programs
- » Summer Learning
- » Distance and Hybrid Learning
- » Core Subject Skills Development

Training Solutions

- » Professional Development
- » Teacher Coaching
- » New Teacher Mentoring

The federal government has more than 30 funding resources and grant programs for education, with several new resources to help school districts address learning loss and professional development gaps due to COVID-19. Examples include:

ARP Act / ESSER III Fund **NEW FUNDING RESOURCE!**

\$12 Billion

- » Texas to receive approximately \$12 Billion
- » Provides emergency relief funding to states and school districts to address learning loss through the implementation of evidence-based interventions and summer learning, extended day/year, and after-school programs

CRRSA Act / ESSER II Fund **NEW FUNDING RESOURCE!**

\$5.5 Billion

- » Texas eligible for approximately \$5.5 Billion
- » Provides emergency relief funding to address learning loss and offer summer and after-school programs

Title I – Funding for Economically Disadvantaged Schools

\$1.5 Billion

- » Texas eligible for approximately \$1.5 Billion
- » Provides funding to schools with a high percentage of children from low-income families and to lowest-performing schools

Title II – Professional Development for Educators

\$2 Billion

- » Approximately \$2 Billion per year nationally
- » Provides funding to support effective instruction and improve the quality of educators and administrators

Title IV – Student Support and Academic Achievement (Part B)

\$1.2 Billion

- » Approximately \$1.2 Billion per year nationally
- » Provides funding for activities to advance student achievement, such as after-school programs, summer school programs, digital learning, and other forms of learning and remediation
